John Hoover, Executive Director of Neighborhood Properties, Inc. (NPI), shared their mission: to eliminate homelessness for people living with mental illness. NPI, one of the first permanent supportive housing corporations, employs 70 people and owns 155 apartments. NPI staff member, John Whitlow, conducts outreach on the streets and tries to engage individuals in mental health treatment and get them into housing. The success of NPI's programs is based on their belief that every individual is valued and treated with dignity and respect. According to Mr. Hoover: "we don't see the illness; we see the person first."

NPI offers stable, affordable, supportive housing with a heart. Their objective is to get individuals into housing, keep them housed and prepare them to re-enter the community. At least 50% of NPI staff report a personal history or close experience with mental illness, substance use disorder or experienced domestic violence; and, 35% of the staff

reported having been homeless at least one time in their life.

The profile of NPI tenants include:

503 adults and 104 children

24% are between the ages of 45-54

44% are black or African Americans and 42% are white

33% experienced domestic violence

average length of stay at NPI properties is 3.5 years



NPI's most recent building (above) is the Wellness and Recovery Center where persons can stay up to seven days. Services at this center are designed to defuse situations and not to address a crisis. It is located on Glendale at the site of the former Glendale Flowers.

NPI is funded in part by the Mental Health & Recovery Services Board of Lucas County. Mr. Hoover invited Rotarians to consider joining the NPI Board of Directors. If you are interested, please call 419-473-2604. The Board meets once a month at 7:30 a.m. and there is no fundraising obligation.
