Lisa Krebs is the Executive Director of Girls on the Run of Northwest Ohio. Girls on the Run is a life-changing program for girls in 3rd-8th grade. The mission is to inspire girls to be joyful, healthy and confident using a fun experience-based curriculum which creatively integrates running.

More than a running program, they make lasting transformative change in the lives of girls. Some programs focus on sports skills and some programs focus on life skills we focus equally on both which makes us unique.

We offer an elementary program, Girls on the Run, for 3rd – 5th grade girls and a Middle School program, Heart & Sole for 6-8 grade girls. Our program is typically held after-school at schools, community centers, parks & recs, YMCA's, etc.

Girls on the Run is a National organization, with a network of over 200 councils throughout the United States. What started with 13 girls in 1996 has grown into a national force for good with over 1.4 million girls participating throughout our 21 year history. Girls on the Run serves over 200,000 girls annually with the help of over 100,000 volunteers. Many people are familiar with the Girls on the Run 5K, the culminating event of the 10-week curriculum. Our organization hosts the

world's largest 5K series by number of events with over 330 events per year.

Over the course of 10 weeks, Trained coaches lead small teams of girls through our research-based curricula which includes dynamic discussions, and fun activities. Running is used as a platform for teaching life skills.
